

## SLASPA AIRPORT DEPARTMENT HOSTS SUCCESSFUL AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL OFFICERS TRAINING PROGRAMME

On the afternoon of Friday September 2, 2016 the closing ceremony for the Air Traffic Control Officers (ATCO) Refresher Training was held at the VIP Lounge at HIA.
