AIRPORTS

George F. L. Charles Airport

The George F.L. Charles Airport during the month of August facilitated a total of 2,103 aircraft movements and 25,714 international and domestic passengers in and out of the airport in addition to 6,519 intransit passengers. The airport also handled 96,705 kilograms of cargo set down and picked up.

Hewanorra International Airport

The Hewanorra International Airport (HIA) recorded a total of 1,141 domestic and international aircraft movements during the month. At HIA 56,941 passengers disembarked and embarked. The airport also recorded 7,912 intransit passengers. Cargo throughput (landed and loaded) at HIA for the month was 142,402 kilograms.

Cargo Operations at Port Castries

During the month Port Castries handled container throughput of 1,391 TEUS landed and 1,477 TEUS loaded. The Port recorded break-bulk cargo throughput of 6,690 tons landed and 44 tons loaded.

The Port recorded 46 cargo vessels.

Ferry Traffic

The summer months of July and August represents a peak in the ferry traffic during the year.

This month the Ferry Terminal welcomed 18 ferry calls carrying 10,674 passengers in (4,939) and out (5,735).
