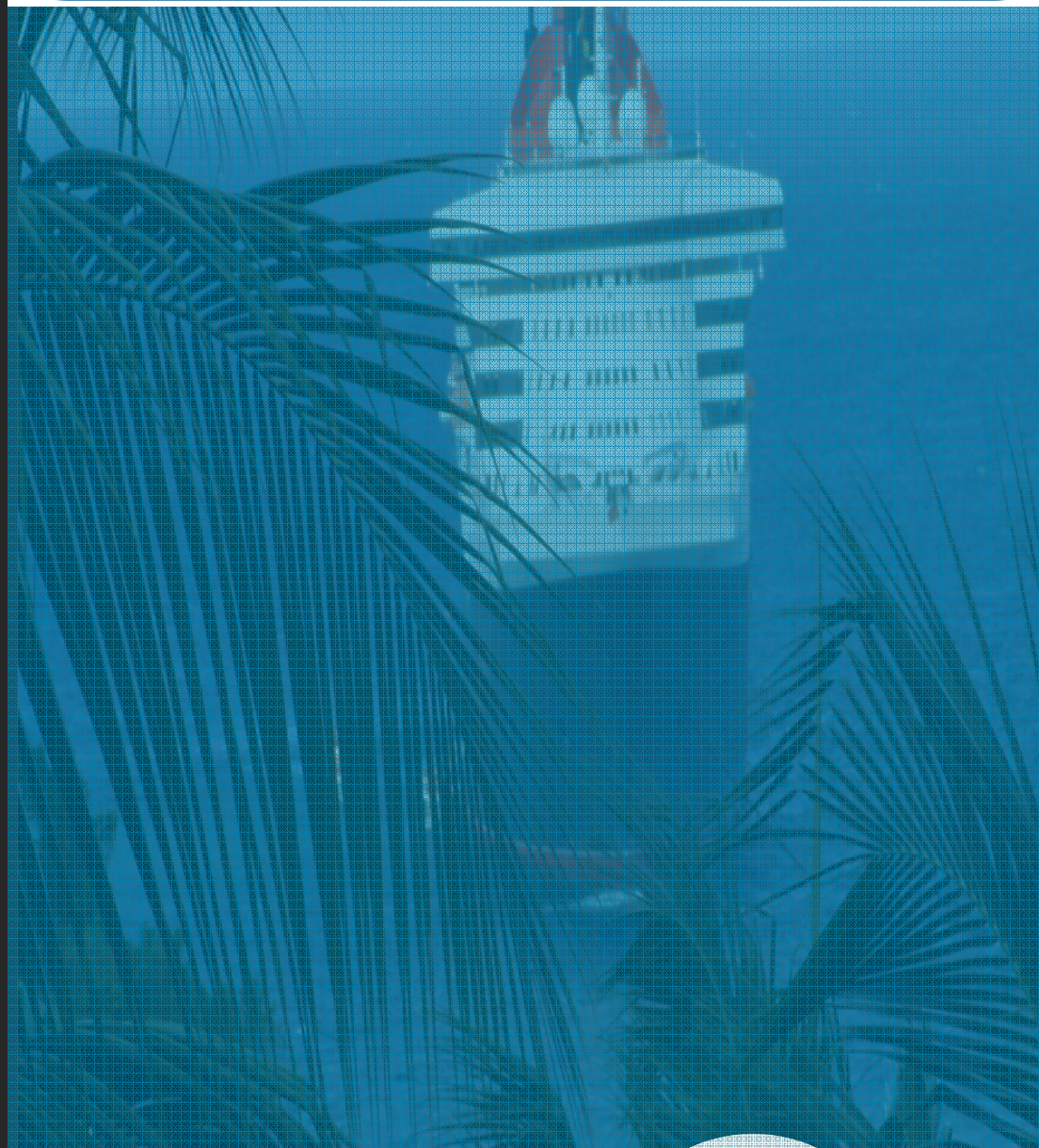

George F. L. Charles Airport

George F.L. Charles Airport (GFLC) during the month of April facilitated 1,933 aircraft movements which accommodated 19,408 international and domestic passengers and 5,115 intransit passengers. The airport also recorded 108,231 kilograms of cargo set down and picked up.

Hewanorra International Airport

Hewanorra International Airport (HIA) recorded a total of 1,073 domestic and international aircraft movements for the month. The airport facilitated 46,758 passengers (picked-up and set-down) as well as 5,533 intransit passengers. Cargo throughput (landed and loaded) at HIA for the month was 116,837 kilograms.



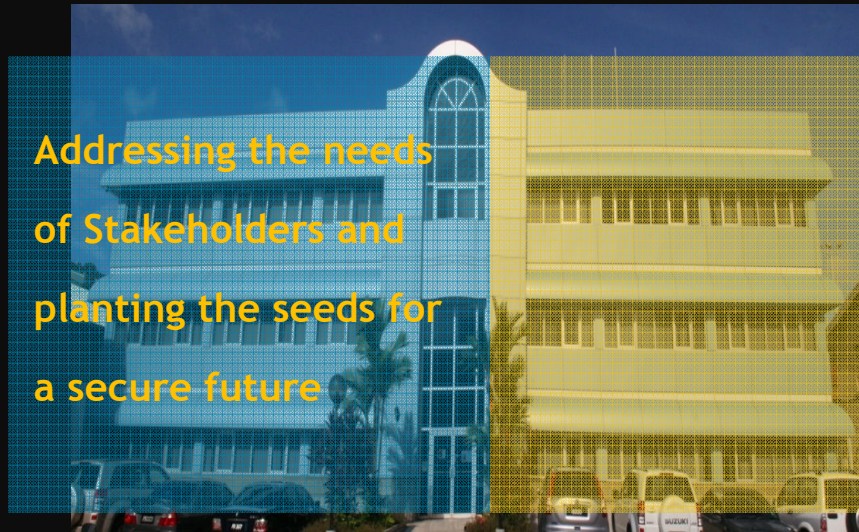

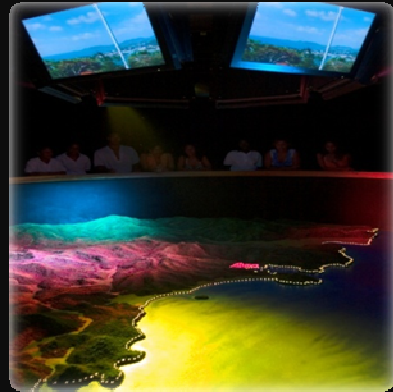
SEAPORTS *Cruise*

Cargo Operations at Port Castries

During the month of April Port Castries handled container throughput of 1,113 TEUS landed and 917 TEUS loaded. Break-bulk cargo throughput was 6,254 tons landed and 106 tons loaded.

This month Port Castries recorded 44 cargo vessels which discharged containers as well as break-bulk cargo including construction material, vehicles and other general cargo.

Ferry Traffic

The Ferry Terminal this month welcomed 14 ferry calls carrying 5,533 passengers in (2,608) and out (2,925) of the Ferry Terminal at Port Castries.
